Breast Cancer Detection Camp

“Cancer Research Project” undertaken by Ayurved Hospital & Research Centre of Bharatiya Sanskriti Darshan Trust, Wagholi organized a “Breast Cancer Detection Camp” for women at Ayurved Hospital & Research Centre, Wagholi under the guidance of Prof. Dr. S. P. Sardeshmukh on 25th November 2008.

The Aim of this health camp was to perform general breast examination in women & F. N. A. C. test of breast lump if required. General health check up of women was also done in the camp. Guidance about awareness of women’s diseases and their prevention was also given in the camp.

The Camp was started at 9:00 am. A total of 43 women & 6 children benefited from this camp.

Breast lump was detected in 5 patients. F. N. A. C. test of Breast lump was done by Dr. Deepak Ladda, Pathologist, Ayurved Hospital & Research Centre in minimum charges (20 Rs.).
